**Rotary Clubs of South and North Jacksonville Donate \$90,000  
From Gingerbread Project To 24 Local Charities**

Jacksonville, Fla.; June 22, 2009 – With the profits from the 2008 annual Gingerbread Extravaganza, the Rotary Club of South Jacksonville and the Rotary Club of North Jacksonville donated \$90,000 to 24 local charities, organizations and non-profit projects.

The two Rotary Clubs teamed up to conduct the fifth annual Gingerbread Extravaganza that showcases gingerbread houses during the holidays. The clubs designated three major charities to receive the largest contributions. They include HabiJax (\$35,000), Ronald McDonald House (\$20,000) and the Jacksonville Historical Society (\$12,500).

The remaining funds were distributed to following... Since the beginning of the Gingerbread Extravaganza five years ago, the Rotary Club of South Jacksonville has donated over a half a million dollars to date to local charities from the event's proceeds.
